### APPLIANCE – FUEL PUMP – TEMPERATURE TEST

**Applicability:** to airplanes equipped with fuel pumps LUN 6285.84 serial numbers listed in Attachment No.:1 of Mandatory Service Bulletin No.: 01-JSV-04a, produced by JIHOSTROJ a.s. Velešín Company.

**Reason:** Operation of above mentioned fuel pumps indicates that is not possible to ensure during low temperatures safety function of these fuel pumps.

Effective date: May 13, 2004

### **Compliance:**

For renewal of airworthiness of above mentioned fuel pumps in ambient temperature to -55°C is necessary to perform temperature test of fuel pump in accordance with Mandatory Service Bulletin No.: 01-JSV-04a which becomes herewith part of this AD and can be obtained from: JIHOSTROJ a.s., 382 32 VELEŠÍN, Czech Republic. Fuel pump must be sent to the producer to perform temperature test at -55°C.

Remarks: The compliance of this AD must be recorded in Aircraft Logbook, where applicable the requirements of this AD must be integrated into Aircraft Technical Documentation.
